



Of the 198 students who earned baccalaureate degrees from the College of Education and Health Sciences in 2022-2023, outcome response data was gathered from 176 students. Data indicate that 72% of graduates are employed and 25% of graduates are continuing their education. Graduates are employed at over 125 different organizations. Information was obtained from 99% (1987/201 graduates) of the undergraduate class from the Caterpillar College of Engineering with a 97% career outcome rate, 93% (185) were employed and 4% (7) persued Graduate education. The 97% career outcome rate is consistent with national trends, and along with 2021-2022, represents the highest rate over the past 10 years. Engineering graduates shared salary data at a far higher rate than the other colleges (77%), an increase of 5% over the previous year. Salaries met or exceeded national averages shared by NACE, Graduates are employed at 131 different organizations in 19 states. Notable employers include Caterpillar Inc., Northrop Grumman Corporation, Actalent Services, Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. - CMT, HNI | HON | Allsteel, and Milwaukee Tool, and Deere & Company, Farnsworth Group, IMEG Corp, and Komatsu America Corp, Graduates continuing their education enrolled at Bradley University as well as Purdue University, and UIC. *Rick Smith, Ph.D., Career Advisor*

The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences produces the most graduates (288) among each baccalaureate class. Most graduates directly entered the workforce (58%) while the rate attending graduate school (21%) is the highest at Bradley. Some employers include: Illinois Mutual, RSM, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois, Boeing, Case Western Reserve, Brookfield Zoo, Dell, Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, Goldman Sachs, Maui Jim, Mayo Clinic, Northern Trust Corporation, Oakridge Institute, Owens Corning, Stryker, Tampa Bay Rays, and UL LLC. Some graduate school destinations include: Northwestern, Washington (St Louis), Illinois, Michigan, Oklahoma, Nebraska, UlC and the University of Connecticut Health. 



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

New This Year

The Turner School of Entrepreneurship and Innovation is included in this report for the second time. As there are likely to be a small number of graduates annually, outcome rates may be expected to vary substantially year to year.

The First Destination Study has traditionally reported on the internship and experiential learning history of each graduating class. For several years, the FDS has used a broad definition of experiential learning, here called Experiential Activity, which included but was not limited to registered internships. Since the 2022 First Destination Study, the percentage of students completing a Registered Internship is reported. Registered internships are approved by representatives of each College, and require students to enroll in a co-op/internship course, which integrates classroom theory with career-related work experience. Many of the graduates in this report matriculated prior to the inclusion of Experiential Learning as a Core Practice of the Bradley University Core Curriculum.

Scope and Methodology

This report includes data about the August 2022, December 2022, and May 2023 Bradley University baccalaureate and graduate degree recipients. The study utilizes data from 89% of all baccalaureate degree recipients and 91% of all advanced degree recipients. Data were collected from students via graduation fair surveys, online surveys, telephone/email/text solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers. Due to staff challenges in communicating with graduates, a final effort was made by mailing postcards to the family address of selected graduates in December 2023. Data collection concluded December 31, 2023.

Career Outcomes and Knowledge Rate

The Bradley University career outcomes rate for the 2022-2023 baccalaureate graduating class is 93%, which is slightly above the five-year average (91%). The graduating class experienced the COVID-19 Pandemic, which continues to influence outcomes and averages.

The career outcomes rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who are employed or continuing their education by the total number of students about whom we have information. We successfully contacted, surveyed, and/or researched 1,011 of our baccalaureate graduates, which resulted in an 89% knowledge rate. The term "knowledge rate" defines the percentage of graduates for whom we have reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities. Our knowledge rate is considerably higher than the national recommended minimum knowledge rate of 65%.

Registered Internships

The Bradley University registered internship rate for the 2022-2023 baccalaureate graduating class is 37%. Of the 1,014 graduates, 37% (377) had a *registered* internship. Baccalaureate graduates conducted *registered* internships with 259 different employers. The rated of registered internships increased from 25% in 2021-2022 to 37% in 2022-2023.

Employers

Baccalaureate degree graduates were employed with 486 different employers in 31 states and 2 countries. Graduate Degree Recipients were employed with 358 different employers in 41 states, 1 US Territory, and 4 countries. The diversity of employers is a benefit for our graduates.

Smith Career Center

76% of baccalaureate graduates used the services of the Smith Career Center while attending Bradley University. In 2022-2023, we provided 27 workshops for ALL students and 90 presentations to classes or groups. 3,229 students utilized the services of the Smith Career Center. Smith Career Center staff provided 3,436 one-on-one appointments. We remained a top source of job leads for accepted positions when students utilized resources such as internships, job fairs, and Bradley netWORK.

Standards and Protocols

The terminology, standards, and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) are utilized throughout this study. NACE is the preeminent national organization focused on the employment of the college educated.

The NACE First-Destination Survey Standards and Protocols encourage continuous engagement with graduates so that data collection is ongoing rather than episodic, accept a variety of legitimate sources of finding critical outcome information, and support the collection of data that are reliable and verifiable. Some students in this class had indicated that they were seeking employment prior to their graduation. Multiple attempts were made to verify this information: by email, text, phone call, and traditional mail; through internet searches including social media searches; by examining activity evidence in Bradley netWORK; and by outreach to academic faculty and student services staff. If we had no other information collected at any time after their graduation, we were unable to verify the accuracy of their status so these students were classified as Not Reported.
