- (a) Engineering majors must take the 2nd English Composition (C2) course at Bradley.
- (b) Majors in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences are required to take 3 hours in each Human Values category (3 hours Philosophy (HP) and 3 hours Literature (HL)).
- (c) Majors in the College of Business should take Introduction to Psychology + Introduction to Sociology. Education majors are required to take Introduction to American Government while Introduction to Psychology is recommended. Education majors should see an advisor for other options.
- (d) Several majors require Calculus. Check a Bradley catalog or a Bradley advisor.
- (e) May only be used to satisfy one gen ed category.
- (f) HIST 101 or HIST 102, individually, will satisfy the NW gen ed requirement.
If both HIST 101 and HIST 102 are taken, then they satisfy both the WC and the NW gen ed requirements.

Engineering and Education majors may require a general education course at the 300 level. Please consult a Bradley advisor.
