



## **ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN LEADERSHIP IN HUMAN SERVICES ADMINISTRATION**

Applications and nominations are invited for a full-time tenure track faculty position in Leadership in Human Service Administration in the Department of Educational Leadership and Human Development. This position is available August 16, 2010 with opportunities for interim sessions and summer work.
