



ASSISTANT PROFESSOR, DEPARTMENT OF TEACHER EDUCATION

The Department of Teacher Education invites applications for a tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level to begin Fall 2010.

An earned doctorate in Curriculum and Instruction or a related field is required; however ABD will be considered with expected completion by August 2010. Qualified applicants must have background and teaching experience in elementary education with experience in reading/language arts. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, teaching undergraduate and graduate courses and supervision of field experiences, as well as scholarship and service. At least three years of teaching experience in K-8 is required, with P-3 experience preferred. Must be able to access non-ADA compliant facilities.

The department offers undergraduate programs in Early Childhood Education; Elementary Education, K-12 programs in Art, Foreign Language, and Music; Secondary Education; Special Education (Learning Behavior Specialist I); and Learning Behavior Specialist I/Elementary Education Program. Approximately 800 students are currently enrolled in these programs. The department offers a graduate program in Curriculum and Instruction. The university also offers two professional master of arts programs for teachers, one for elementary teachers in STEM areas and the other for secondary teachers in environmental science.
