



Assistant/Associate Professor Position in Structural Engineering.

The Department of Civil Engineering and Construction at Bradley University invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant/Associate Professor levels starting in January or August of 2010 in the area of Structural Engineering. Duties include teaching graduate and undergraduate courses, supervising students, and attracting funded research. Salary and rank are commensurate with qualifications.

Applicants should have a B.S. in Civil Engineering. This position requires an earned doctorate with specialization in Structural Engineering and emphasis in engineering mechanics and/or structural design. Registration as a PE in any state is desirable.
