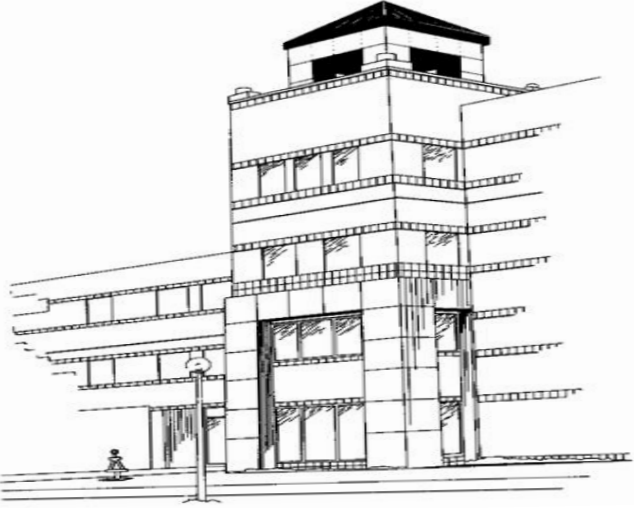

THE PURPOSE OF PAC

As stated in the Personnel Advisory Committee Advisory Committee Constitution, the purpose of this committee is:

- A. To review and recommend, where appropriate, official personnel policy which specifically relates to non-exempt, non-union personnel, which impacts the areas of fringe benefits, Affirmative Action, Sexual Harassment, employment processes and working conditions.
- B. To receive periodical reports or attend informational sessions, which directly involve non-exempt, non-union employee policies or practices, from the Vice President of Business Affairs and the Director of Human Resources.
- C. When deemed necessary, consult with the Director of Human Resources for information or clarification of subject matters relevant and germane to non-exempt, non union personnel.

PAC is NOT a bargaining unit or a union. Any PAC Representative WILL be glad to try to find answers to questions from any non-exempt, non-union staff member. If your representative cannot find answers to your question, your PAC President, will contact the appropriate person to get answer for your question.
