# Directions for Completing the Application for Undergraduate Student-at-Large

Please read the following information to be considered for admission as an undergraduate student-at-large (SLU).

## 1. What is an undergraduate student-at-large?

An undergraduate student-at-large (SLU) is an individual who does not have an undergraduate degree, does not wish to receive an undergraduate degree from Bradley University, but would like to take classes on a part-time basis.

## 2. Who can apply?

- High school students who have completed their sophomore year and have a B or better grade point average.
- College students who wish to take a course and transfer it back to their current institution.
- A person who wishes to take a class for personal or professional development.

## 3. Who should *not* apply as an undergraduate student-at-large?

- Students who wish to receive an undergraduate degree from Bradley University. (Contact the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.)
- Students who already have a degree. (Contact the Graduate School.)
- Students whose grade point average is below 2.0.

## 4. What information is needed to complete my application?

- Fill out the Application for undergraduate student-at-large.

### *College students*

- Provide with the application an official transcript or letter of good standing from current or most recent institution.

### *International students*

- Provide with the application an official transcript, *and*
- A letter from your current institution stating that you are a full-time student, are in good standing, and have permission to take a course at Bradley.
- A copy of current I-20

### *High school students*

- Provide with the application an official transcript, *and*
- Three letters of recommendation from high school teachers or guidance counselors.

### *Others*

- Provide with the application most recent college transcript, *or*
- letter of recommendation from employer, *or*
- personal statement if neither of the above is available.

## 5. What are some additional admission procedures I need to be aware of?

- Admission as an SLU does not guarantee registration in a course.
- Prerequisite requirements as specified in the course catalog must be met.
- Undergraduate students-at-large are not eligible to receive financial assistance.
- Admission as an SLU does not guarantee admission to a degree program at a later time.
- If you become a degree-seeking student later, a maximum of 45 hours of the SLU completed course work can be applied toward an undergraduate degree at Bradley.

## 5. How do I register for my class(es)?

Once your information is received, you will be reviewed for admission. Once you are notified of your admission status, you will also receive information about registering for courses. Registration is accomplished via Webster, Bradley's web-based registration system (<http://webster.bradley.edu>), using the Bradley Identification (ID) number and the Bradley Registration Number (BRN). Both the ID and BRN will be provided 48 hours after admission is approved.
