



REMINDERS

Student Body Officer Elections

Student Body Officer elections are scheduled for April 3 & 4. As in the past, they will be held on-line, so the ballot will be available for a total of 33 hours. The ballot will open at 8:00am on April 3 and close promptly at 5:00pm on April 4. Candidates may begin public campaigning at midnight on March 20.

This year, candidates will be able to run as a ticket. The ticketing system has

been established so that candidates can pool financial resources and establish a common platform on which to run. Tickets may be comprised of two, three or four candidates.

Details of the ballot are still being worked out. Voters will be able to vote in each individual race as they like. For example, you can select an entire ticket or just vote for three out of the

four members. The goal is not to force an entire slate on the voters and to allow for individual candidates to effectively run a campaign.
