

**Center for Teaching Excellence and Learning Request for Proposals:
Fall Forum Scholarly Showcase**



The Center for Teaching Excellence and Learning (CTEL) invites Bradley faculty and full-time staff to submit a scholarly abstract for presentation at Fall Forum 2022. Up to 12 abstracts will be selected through peer review for 15-minute presentations at the Fall Forum on Wednesday, August 17th.

The Scholarly Showcase is intended to highlight recent research and creative production at Bradley, and to advance an appreciation of scholarly contributions originating across Bradley's many disciplines.

Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts should be no longer than 200 words, submitted as a double-spaced word document.
- Abstracts should include title, but not authors as abstracts will be subjected to blind review.
- Save documents using up to 3 keywords from title (e.g., COVID_Cognition_Undergraduates)
- Submit abstract to sag@fsmail.bradley.edu, and include authors in email text.
- Deadline for submission is May 1, 2022

Review Criteria

- Completed projects will be given priority, but in-progress projects will be considered.
- Projects that include the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning are encouraged.
- Projects that advance an understanding of Diversity, Equity or Inclusion are encouraged.
- Projects that include human or animal research subjects should be prepared to offer appropriate documentation by the appropriate institutional review committee upon request.
- If the project has been previously presented at a national or regional conference, or has been submitted for publication, please provide that information in the text of the submission email.
- Projects that have been published or previously presented/exhibited in 2020, 2021 or 2022 will be given preference over older projects.

Authors will be notified of acceptance by June 1, 2022.
