

## **Spring 2024 Grant Writing Workshop**

Are you interested in identifying additional funding to support your research or to fund a curricular innovation? Have you tried to secure funding but were unsuccessful, or do you have limited experience preparing proposals and are unsure where to begin? Whether you fall into the above categories or are an experienced grant writer, please consider registering for the workshop which is jointly sponsored by the *OSF Jump Trading Simulation & Education Center, the University of Illinois College of Medicine (UICOMP), Illinois State University, and Bradley University.* 

This remotely delivered multi-week workshop will be held on Wednesdays from 12-1 pm, starting on January 31 and ending on April 24. (**Note:** We will not have class on March 13 due to Bradley's Spring Break.) The workshop will include live interactive Zoom sessions and asynchronous modules (see listing below), which national and local experts moderate. The material covered during the workshop will apply to the submission of proposals to any public or private foundation, but the examples used during the workshop will primarily relate to the National Institute of Health, the National Science Foundation, the Agency for Health Research and Quality, the National Institute for Nursing Research, and the Innovation for Health (IFH) grant program.

All Bradley Employees are eligible to attend, but currently, we are limited to **ten** "seats". The Office of Sponsored Programs will provide "scholarships" to cover the course cost (\$200 per participant). Fees are collected to cover the external speaker honoraria.

Please consider taking advantage of this opportunity, which will provide tools to shape your ideas into a competitive proposal. Participation will also provide networking opportunities with researchers at Bradley and in the community. In addition, Continuing Education (CE) credit is available.
