## **PARTICIPANTS**

Welcome to Bradley University's orientation and to the Bradley family.

The day will consist of learning, networking, connecting with others and becoming familiar with campus, or as we call it here, your new home away from home. We want your day to be as enjoyable and safe as possible.

Our presenters have a set of guidelines and expectations and whether you are a student or a supporter, you have a similar set. Please review the list below.

- 1) Please wear a facemask at all times. If you don't have a mask, we can provide you with one.
- Please maintain safe physical distancing (approximately two arm lengths apart).
- 3) Each presenter, where applicable, will have a **presenter space designated by tape on the floor**. Please respect the presenter's personal space.
- 4) If you have questions during a presentation and need to use a microphone, there'll be microphones located on stands in the aisles. Otherwise, raise your hand and ask your question. Please don't congregate in the aisles.

- 5) We ask you to **follow the flow of traffic** in and out of all presentation spaces by the markings on the floors and/or doorways. Please use appropriate exit and entry doorways.
- 6) **If you aren't feeling well** prior to your session, we ask you to contact the Orientation office and reschedule your session. We'll work with you as best as we can to reschedule.
- 7) If you aren't feeling well during your session, let a member of the orientation team, a presenter or a university official know as soon as possible.
