- (a) Engineering majors must take the 2nd English Composition (C2) course at Bradley at the 300 course level.
- (b) Majors in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences are required to take 3 hours in each Human Values category (3 hours Philosophy HP and 3 hours Literature HL).
- (c) Majors in the College of Business should take Introduction to Psychology + Introduction to Sociology. Education majors should check with Bradley to see which SF gen ed are the best choices for their major.
- (d) Several majors require Calculus. Check the current Bradley catalog or a Bradley advisor.
- (e) HIST 111 or HIST 112, individually, will satisfy the NW gen ed requirement. If both HIST 111 and HIST 112 are taken, then they satisfy both the WC and the NW gen ed requirements.
- (f) ART 152 and HUM 125 may be used to satisfy only one gen ed requirement each.

Engineering and Education majors may require a general education course at the 300 level. Please consult a Bradley advisor.
