Information was obtained from 99% of the undergraduate class (137 graduates, 136 respondents), resulting in a 95% career outcome rate: 91% are employed, and 4% are pursuing graduate school. Salaries met or exceeded the national averages reported by NACE. Some notable employers of graduates include Caterpillar Inc., Boeing, Ford Motor Company, GE Healthcare, General Dynamics Electric Boat, Komatsu America Corp. and Northrop Grumman Corporation. Graduates continuing their education have enrolled at Bradley University, Johns Hopkins University, University of Illinois -- Urbana-Champaign, and Washington University in St. Louis. 



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

New This Year

This First Destination Study has combined graduation and outcome data from some majors to enhance our reporting. Bradley University academic departments frequently offer multiple related major courses of study, and these are not static. Combining closely related majors and assigning them a shared name allows more informative reporting and often supports the inclusion of salary information that otherwise wouldn't be publicly available. More finely differentiated outcome data may be available upon request from the Smith Career Center.

All recipients of doctoral and master's degrees, and recipients of post-baccalaureate certificates, are now called Post-Baccalaureate Graduates in this study.

Scope and Process

This report includes data about the August 2024, December 2024, and May 2025 Bradley University baccalaureate and graduate degree recipients. The study utilizes data from 86% of all baccalaureate degree recipients and 89% of all advanced degree recipients. Data were collected from students via graduation fair surveys, online surveys, telephone/email/text solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers. Data collection concluded December 31, 2025.

Standards and Protocols

The terminology, standards, and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) are utilized throughout this study. NACE is the preeminent national organization focused on the employment of the college educated.

The NACE First-Destination Survey Standards and Protocols encourage continuous engagement with graduates so that *data collection is ongoing rather than episodic*, accept a variety of *legitimate sources of finding critical outcome information*, and support the collection of data that *are reliable and verifiable*. Some students in this class had indicated that they were seeking employment prior to their graduation. Multiple attempts were made to verify this information: by email, text, and phone call; through internet searches including social media searches; by examining activity evidence in Bradley netWORK; and by outreach to academic faculty and student services staff. If we had no other information collected at any time after their graduation, we were unable to verify the accuracy of their status so these students were classified as Not Reported.

Past communication with NACE Research Staff advised excluding extreme salary outliers defined as values below minimum wage and above \$1,000,000. Minimum wage is defined as the Illinois minimum as of 2025. We retained salary/honorarium data for service work that was below minimum wage.

Career Outcomes and Knowledge Rate

The Bradley University career outcomes rate for the 2024-2025 baccalaureate graduating class is 94%, which is slightly above the five-year average (92%).

The career outcomes rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who are employed or continuing their education by the total number of students about whom we have information. We successfully contacted, surveyed, and/or researched 779 of our baccalaureate graduates, which resulted in an 86% knowledge rate. The term "knowledge rate" defines the percentage of graduates for whom we have reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities. Our knowledge rate is considerably higher than the national recommended minimum knowledge rate of 65%.

Employers

Baccalaureate degree graduates were employed with 393 different employers in 31 states and 5 countries. Graduate Degree Recipients were employed with 319 different employers in 39 states and 3 countries. The diversity of employers is a benefit for our graduates.

Smith Career Center

94% of baccalaureate graduates used the services of the Smith Career Center while attending Bradley University. There are multiple ways for students to engage with the Smith Career Center. 86% of this graduating class engaged in individual meetings with SCC staff members (scheduled one-on-one appointments, walk-ins, phone meetings, and significant email engagements). 66% of the class attended at least one career fair.

Internships and Experiential Learning

The First Destination Study has traditionally reported on the internship and experiential learning history of each graduating class. Since the 2022 First Destination Study, the percentage of students completing a Registered Internship is reported along with the percentage of students completing an Experiential Learning activity. Registered internships are approved by representatives of each College and require students to enroll in a co-op/internship course, which integrates classroom theory with career-related work experience. Experiential Learning is a required Core Practice of the Bradley University Core Curriculum. Some members of this graduating class who were admitted before Fall 2020, or who transferred to Bradley University, were not subject to this specific requirement.

Registered Internships

The Bradley University registered internship rate for the 2024-2025 baccalaureate graduating class is 32%. Of the 901 graduates, 32% (290) had a *registered* internship. Baccalaureate graduates conducted *registered* internships with 231 different employers. More than 15% of these employers hired the same intern for two or more semesters. The rate of registered internships varied from 25% in 2021-2022 to 37% in 2022-2023 to 40% in 2023-2024 to 32% in 2024-2025.
