On Tuesday, July 16, 2024 at approximately 3:20 a.m., we learned telephone outage had occurred on campus and is impacting telephone service across campus. On March 15, at approximately 7:13 a.m., Bradley University Police responded to a reported hate crime in the 1300 block of W. Fredonia Avenue.

Upon investigation, on March 15, 2024 between the hours of approximately 3:45 a.m. and 4:22 a.m., a suspect spray-painted graffiti at various campus locations. The crime appears to be motivated by bias directed toward a religious group.

BUPD takes this crime extremely seriously, and asks for your assistance in identifying the suspect in this video. Attached are still pictures of the suspect.

There is no imminent threat to campus.

An investigation is continuing.
