

Student Business Travel Certification Form

A completed Student Business Travel Certification Form must be submitted with all expense reports requesting reimbursement to a student for university business travel in order for the payment to be made on a tax-free basis under the University Accountable Plan rules. Note: Lack of adequate documentation supporting business travel may delay processing or result in payment being classified as scholarship/fellowship or award to the student.

Examples of University Business Travel:

- Travel undertaken by a student for the purpose of presenting research at a conference (including poster presentations), where the student is formally recognized in the publication or program as a presenter or contributor from Bradley University.
- Student travel for participation in a competition where the student officially represents Bradley University.
- Student travel conducted for the purpose of university research, with the explicit intent of generating useful results for the institution.
- Travel associated with research activities performed to fulfill the University's obligations to external funding agencies.

Examples of Scholarship/Fellowship or Award Travel:

- Travel undertaken for a student's project or research where the primary purpose is to advance the student's individual education or academic program.
- Student travel to attend a conference, where the objective is solely for the student's personal educational enrichment and development.
- Travel for dissertation research that is conducted primarily to fulfill the requirements
 of a degree program and does not represent research the University would
 independently undertake.
