- Check the status of a claim and your claims history

- View and print an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) statement for a claim
- > Locate a doctor or hospital in the network
- Select an option to stop receiving EOBs in the mail
- Sign up to receive claim status email alerts
- Request a new or replacement member ID card or print a temporary member ID card
- Access your account through your mobile device and opt in for texting wellness updates


