

LOAN AGREEMENT (MPN) FOR FEDERAL STUDENT LOANS

Subsidized/Unsubsidized and/or PLUS loans

What is a Loan Agreement (Master Promissory Note)?

The federal government <u>requires</u> you to complete a Loan Agreement (Master Promissory Note) before your first federal loans can be disbursed to Bradley University on your behalf. A Loan Agreement (MPN) is a legal document explaining terms and conditions of your loan(s) and your promise to repay your loan(s) and any accrued interest and fees to the US Department of Education.

Should I complete a Loan Agreement (MPN)?

If you have not previously received a loan under the federal Direct Loan Program, you must complete the Loan Agreement (MPN) in order to utilize Subsidized/Unsubsidized and/or PLUS loans.

** Completing a Loan Agreement (MPN) does <u>not</u> lock you in to borrowing. You may complete a Loan Agreement (MPN) even if you decide not to take federal student loans. **

How do I complete a Loan Agreement (MPN)?

Within a few business days, the federal government will notify Bradley University that you have completed Entrance Counseling and a Loan Agreement (MPN), and if you decide to accept federal student loans, the funds can be disbursed to your Student Fees account.
